

Creating a Low-Stimulation Environment

- Avoid a clinical feel that means not including bright or highly reflective surfaces. Avoid white.
- Include biophilic elements natureinspired elements like plants, natural light, wood textures or outdoor views
- Acoustics reduce echo and background noise which could be overwhelming
- □ **Is it age-appropriate?** Sixth-form students will have very different needs to a primary or Year 7 student
- ☐ Is there a gradual transition from the SEN room to noisier parts of the school?
